September 1990

Final notification that the plan and application were approved for Bis-Man Transit to receive Urban Mass Transit Authority (UMTA) funding.

1990 Limited paratransit service for individuals with developmental disabilities was started.

December 1989

Transit study results were in. Community too small/not enough interest for fixed route. However, study solidified the need to move forward with paratransit

1988 Transit study of Bismarck and Mandan began.
