Meeting was called to order at 2:00 P.M.

Regular Agenda

1. **Welcome and Introductions:** Deidre stated all meeting attendees.
2. **CTIC Membership Discussion**

Three applicants are seeking reappointment to the group. Kandy, Nate, and Susan had submitted applications. Alissa motioned, seconded by Jeannie, to recommend re-appointing all three members. All in favor, none opposed. Glenn asked Deidre about the process. Deidre said the recommendation would go to the Committee Chair and Board President to make a final determination.

Deidre said the Committee received a CTIC application from a fixed route bus driver. Alissa motioned, seconded by Susan, to recommend appointing the applicant to CTIC. All in favor, none opposed. Glenn asked whether an adjustment would be needed to the CTIC meeting time. Deidre said she would keep a standing meeting day on the Monday before the regular Board meeting; however, she recommended moving the meeting start time to 3:00 pm.

3. **Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan**

Deidre reminded the committee that the Coordinated Human Services Transportation Plan was available to view on the Bis-Man Transit website. 38 responses were received



from the survey. The final plan will be presented at a public hearing meeting held before the September regular Board meeting, when the Board will vote on the plan.

4. Other Business

Glenn asked whether CTIC would be full if the recommendations were approved. Deidre said CTIC would have 9 members from the general public, with 1 opening. Deidre said she believed the Committee Chair and Board President could increase the number if needed.
